



# **ERC Consolidator Grants (CoG)**

The European Research Council (ERC) Consolidator grants provide attractive and long-term funding that supports excellent researchers who want to establish or have recently established a research team and want to continue to strengthen a successful career.

## Who can apply

Researchers of any nationality with 7-12 years of experience since completion of PhD, with a promising track record and an excellent research proposal. Eligibility can be extended under certain circumstances, such as maternity/paternity leave, clinical training military service and long-term illness<sup>1</sup>.

#### Which proposals are eligible

- Any field of research
- Research must be conducted in a public or private research organisation based in an EU member state or associated country.
- One or more team members can be located in a non-European country.

# **Swiss participation in Consolidator Grants**

The current status of **Switzerland** is that of a **non-associated third country**. Scientists based in a Swiss Host institution are not eligible to apply to an ERC CoG grant. The <u>SNSF</u> has been mandated by the Swiss federal government to put in place transitional measures.

#### Success rate

Consolidator Grants are highly competitive with a success rate of 15%.

## **Funding**

Up to € 2 000 000 for a period of five years.

# What to do once the call is open

- Contact your host institution early enough to organise their letter of support.
- Look at past <u>ERC funded projects</u>.
- Contact your <u>ERC National Contact Point</u> or your nearest <u>Regional Office</u> and allow enough time for reviews and feedback of the draft proposal.

## How to apply

The calls are published on the <u>Funding and Tenders Portal</u> which contains all information about the call, the templates, and the submission process. If you do not have an account, you need to <u>register on the portal</u>. After that you can start your submission.
